



GENERAL INFORMATION

EQUIPMENT Boeing 707-420 Intercontinentals or Lockheed Super G Constellations on flights to and from New York, all piloted by U. S. trained and CAA-licensed crews.

BAGGAGE Free baggage allowance is 30 kilos (66 lbs.) for first class, and 20 kilos (44 lbs.) for tourist passengers. Excess weight over free allowance is charged at 1 percent of the first class adult one-way fare per kilo. or 2.2 lbs.

CHUDEN One child under 2 years of age, when accompanied by an adult and not occupying a separate seat, is carried at 10 percent of the adult fare between Mismi and the point of origin or destination in South America. Children over 2 and under 12 years, or a child under 2 occupying a separate seat, or charged orn-balf of the applicable adult of the control of the c

SURCHARGE A surcharge is applied to all jet service.

MEALS All meals in flight are served free, to both first class and tourist passengers.

STOPOVER PRIVILEGES All passengers flying Varig may stop at any city enroute, and on the Varig system, if specified in ticket.

TAXES Any government taxes are in addition to Varig fares.

INSURANCE Trip insurance at low rates is available through your travel agent or at any airport.

RESERVATIONS Passengers must reconfirm their reservations at least 72 hours before departure from any stopover city if departure is more than 72 hours after arrival at the stopover point.

DEPARTURES To facilitate on-time departures, passengers are requested to check in at the airport at the time indicated on their ticket envelope.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION Taxicab or limousine service is available between downtown scheduled check-in points and airports. This is not a Varig service and is at passenger's expense.

CONNECTIONS Flight connections via Varig are available to all cities with scheduled service. Your travel agent, or any Varig office, will arrange these connections for you.
